Bristol City Council Covid Update

What to do if...	Action to take	Return to school when
 ...your child has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Self-isolate Get a test Contact school daily Inform school immediately about test results 	...the test comes back negative and you are better
 ...your child tests positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Self-isolate for at least 10 days Inform school immediately about test results Contact school daily 	...they have completed at least 10 days self-isolation but should stay home longer if they still have a temperature (at least a further 24 hours after temperature ends).
