Homework will be handed out on a Tuesday and collected on the following Monday, this will be the same for all classes. We hope that this simplified system will be more effective. Your support with homework makes a huge difference to your child's progress. Please let your child's class teacher know if you have any questions.

Attendance

Last year we didn't have any weeks when a class had 100% attendance (we had a couple of 99% weeks). It would be amazing if we could regularly celebrate classes getting 100% for the whole week; I know the children are really keen to try and achieve this.
