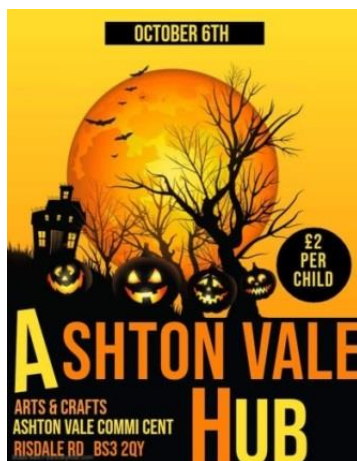
Chess Club starts 10th October
